Course Introduction

The course "Introduction to Dispute Resulution in Sport" is a four-week open course (every week two hours online), offered by the Academy of Leadership Sciences Switzerland.

The course is designed and delivered by recognized experts in Sports Law. It is being offered as an open online course and can be attended by anyone who is, or aspires to get, involved in the industry of sports - including lawyers, sports administrators, sports federations, students, among others.

Course content

The course covers specific topics on legal sport-related issues including the national and international Dispute Resulution in Sport, Disciplinary matters, Disputes & differences - private tribunals and Courts, Dispute Resolution at FIFA, CAS jurisdiction, CAS Procedures and other topics.




Juan de Dios Crespo Pérez, M.Sc. Course Presenter
